



Did you know?

Babies learn from Day 1.

Most brain development takes place between birth and 2 years.
The brain is still developing at birth.

Newborns 'talk' through movements, sounds and the faces they make.

Your baby would rather listen to your voice than any other sound.

Talking and singing with your baby now
is the key to language, learning, reading and writing.

What can you do now?

Smile, talk and sing with your baby from Day 1 (in your own language).

Respond to your baby's 'talk' every time.

Look into your baby's eyes to help your baby look back at you.

Sing or say the same special song or rhyme at bedtime.

Involve your family in talking with your baby.
